4. Registrars Report

Mark and Mike – Procedures/instructions on website need to be downloaded and read. Clean up your databases. Esp. US Swim designations as they can complicate champs entries. Be sure divers have correct designation for division and the letter D as described in diving procedures document. Be sure rosters are sent to all appropriate registrars. Divers must go to both diving reg. and swim registrar. Rosters due by coach's mtg. Make sure all athletes are rostered appropriately. Athletes must be on the roster for 10 days before they compete in ANY meet, official or unofficial. Be sure you have your releases sent to the appropriate registrars. Remember that you can request a copy of the rosters your team submitted to check. Any athlete not rostered/released properly will result in forfeit of meet. When submitting meet results be sure to have all back-ups, pdf's, etc... in body of email please post name of teams competing and score. Directions are on the website.
