	Deck changes are prohibited.		
	Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Vice President of Program Operations of USA Swimming.		
ENTRY LIMITATIONS	Swimmers may enter a maximum of five (5) events, 3 Individual and 2 Relays. Swimmers may not swim an event at League Championships and B Champ		
	'Fly-over' starts will be used at this meet. All swimmers (except for backstroke starts) should remain in the water at the completion of their race until the next heat has begun.

EVENTS & SEEDING	Event order will follow standard SAL meet format including relays. All events are pre-seeded. Seeding adjustments may be made to consolidate heats. We will collect relay names the day of the meet.
